#### A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENT

Here we are in March – as the expression states, it's the month that comes in like a Lion and goes out like a Lamb. Lest we forget that

right in the middle of the month we have the "Ides of March" (If you're a Roman Emperor that's a time to beware). More importantly Easter, one of the holiest Christian holidays, falls on the last day of the Month. It is our hope that the blessings of this holiday fall upon everyone.

The rehabilitation of the auditorium is underway. The contractors appear to be on track with the schedule for repairs. The plan is to have inspections and approvals for all permits that were drawn for the rehabilitation of building C by mid-April. But as we all know, that is under perfect conditions. Our hope is we will be back in the building for May at the latest. As we move forward, we will keep everyone informed as we progress with the project.

March is also the month when a call for candidates is made for the Board of Trustees. This year there are three seats that will become available. Candidates can express their desire to participate beginning on April 1st and officially the process will close on April 19th. Candidates can either submit their own information or be nominated by a member in good standing (after obtaining the candidate's consent). All candidates must also be members in "good standing." The purpose of the timeline is to provide the candidates with the opportunity to have their bios published in the May & June editions of the Southwind. In July, those that are elected will be sworn into office and will, most likely, be required to comply, on or before January 1, 2025, with State and Federal regulations related to the Corporate Transparency Act that was signed into law and became effective in January of this year. Although this is currently a requirement, the Association's attorneys at Becker & Poliakoff and others are attempting to revise the law to exclude Community Associations from this law. However, at this time the Act does govern Board members. Unless there are revisions to the law, by January 1, 2025, each Board member will be required to provide (confidentially), at a minimum the following:

6

- 1. Their full legal name
- 2. Their date of birth
- 3. A complete current address
- 4. A non-expired government issued ID
- 5. A non-expired passport or
- 6. A non-expired driver's license.

The civil and criminal penalties for failing to comply are significant and if you are interested in being a candidate those penalties can be provided to you. We want to wish everyone who decides to participate in this process the best of luck since being on the Board can be a valuable and interesting experience.

New regulations also require that all HOAs have a reserve study performed a minimum of every 5 years. We are happy to advise the membership that we have been in line with the current requirement and have been using this practice for years. The Falcon Group is our provider for reserve studies. The data in our reserve study is reviewed monthly and each time we move forward with a maintenance project. It has proved an invaluable guide for the Board when assessing the requirements for maintenance projects. Holiday City South is compliant and will continue to comply with this new law. We are also pleased that the reserve requirement has been put in place. This will ensure that future boards continue utilizing this valuable tool.

I'll end this month's message with the following quote: "Your hardest times often lead to the greatest moments of your life. Keep going. Tough situations build strong people in the end." — Roy T. Bennett

We look forward to seeing everyone at the March 14, 2024, Homeowners Meeting.

Sprinkler system maintenance is the responsibility of <u>individual homeowners</u>. Sprinklers need to retract automatically and need to be installed below grade. Sprinkler damages to spray nozzles or heads hit because they are above grade and or not automatically retracting will not be repaired by the mowing contractor. Please, have irrigation system clocks set so all watering is completed by **8:30 AM daily**. <u>If irrigation is running at time of cutting</u>, that section of the lawn <u>will be skipped</u> until the next cutting cycle. If you have a issue with something that was **damaged** <u>during the lawn cutting or some other issue</u>, you must **call the office** and register a lawn complaint so the issue can be looked at and corrected.



<u>Each Cycle is broken down into (8) day zones</u> to complete the entire community. Zones below. It is an <u>estimated time frame</u>. If there are <u>rainy days</u> the <u>time frame is extended</u>.

#### TREES IN THE COMMUNITY

Recently we have had several severe storms. Many of us have had tree limbs and or trees fall. The rule of thumb regarding these fallen trees and/or tree limbs is simple. If a tree or tree limb(s) that are in the common area fall in the common area, we leave the downed tree and/or tree limbs where they fall, unless they are creating a hazard. If a tree or tree limbs from the common area fall onto a member's property, the association will remove them. If a tree and /or tree limb do damage to a homeowner's home, they will have to file through their homeowner's insurance for damages, but the association will have the tree and/or tree limbs removed. Also, if the downed tree and/or tree limbs from a tree are from one that stood on the homeowner's property or the township right of way, the homeowner has responsibility for any damage they may cause. This should clarify the association policy for downed trees and/or tree limbs. If a homeowner has a tree on their property and would like to have it removed and are not sure if that tree is on their property for sure, please call the Code Committee and have them come check on it before removing anything. Berkeley Township requires that you have a permit to remove trees.

If plans are within the guidelines of our By-Laws, an approval letter will be prepared and given to the homeowner and submitted to the Zoning Board Officer of Berkeley Township to obtain a permit.

This pertains to any changes, additions, or alterations on the exterior of the home - roof, siding, paint, driveway, patio, sheds, etc.

Absolutely **NO WORK** can be started without permission from the Homeowners' Association or without a permit. **FINES WILL BE IMPOSED if this is not adhered to.** 

#### **GARBAGE NOTICE**

Garbage is **NOT** to be put out to the curb **before 4:00 PM on Mondays**. This is a Berkeley Township Ordinance and HCS residents must comply. Violators may be issued a fine for non-conformance by the Township and/or HCS. Trash receptacles must be kept in your garage, behind your home, or in an area out of view from the street. Receptacles must be covered and concealed. If you are away, consider having a friend or neighbor place your garbage cans at the curb and return them to their respective out-of-view locations after trash pickup.

With the outbreak of the **COVID-19 virus**, Berkeley Sanitation Department's rules for putting out trash is as follows: *The Township has made key changes to trash pickup. All household trash must be bagged and placed in an outdoor trash receptacle.* Sanitation employees will not pick up trash that is not bagged.






