## TREES IN THE COMMUNITY

Recently we have had several severe storms. Many of us have had tree limbs and or trees fall. The rule of thumb regarding these fallen trees and/or tree limbs is simple. If a tree or tree limb(s) that are in the common area fall in the common area, we leave the downed tree and/or tree limbs where they fall, unless they are creating a hazard. If a tree or tree limbs from the common area fall onto a member's property, the association will remove them. If a tree and /or tree limb do damage to a homeowner's home, they will have to file through their homeowner's insurance for damages, but the association will have the tree and/or tree limbs removed. Also, if the downed tree and/or tree limbs from a tree are from one that stood on the homeowner's property or the township right of way, the homeowner has responsibility for any damage they may cause. This should clarify the association policy for downed trees and/or tree limbs. If a homeowner has a tree on their property and would like to have it removed and are not sure if that tree is on their property for sure, please call the Code Committee and have them come check on it before removing anything. Berkeley Township requires that you have a permit to remove trees.

Memorandum: Board meeting with Legal Counsel regarding the 2024 Election.

Date: July 19, 2024

**Incompleted/recalled election:**

The Board has confirmed their concern that the past election did not have sufficient safeguards in place to determine whether a unit owner was entitled to a half vote or a whole vote. The Association's system was not sufficiently updated to make that determination with certainty. As stated before by counsel, we don't know the number of votes that were affected, but we are sure that it was a substantial enough number to warrant a new election. As well, counsel recommended that the system be able to determine which unit owners are not in good standing and therefore ineligible to vote.

**New 2024 Election:**

The Board met with Counsel for the Association, Karl Meth, Esq and Jon Katz, Esq of Becker to develop a process that closes the gaps and will permit counsel to certify the election. The following process/dates will be followed:

The candidates will be the same as in the last election and therefore there is no need for a candidates meeting. There will be no opportunity to vote by email. There will be no electronic voting. Members who are unable to vote in person can request an absentee ballot from the Business Office with instructions. On the day of the election from 11am to 7pm candidates and board members should not be on the common grounds except to cast their vote.

**Timeline:**

**July 31, 2024** – A Notice of Election will be sent out to the membership.

**August 9, 2024** – A Notice of Delinquency will be mailed out to all delinquent (over 30 days) homeowners. Homeowners who are not delinquent as of the 9th will not receive this Notice.

**August 23, 2024, close of business** – All supporting documents (i.e. death certificates, Powers of Attorney and deeds must be presented to management. After this date, no records will be accepted and votes will be assigned as either one-half or a whole vote. This date will be the record date for the election.

**August 23, 2024, close of business**– Last day to request a mail-in/absentee ballot.

**August 30, 2024, close of business** – All delinquent accounts in our system will set. This is the cutoff date and the time to become current or request an ADR pertaining to this election is over.

**September 5, 2024, by 2pm** – All mail-in/absentee ballots must be received by Counsel.

**September 10, 2024 – 11am – 7pm** voting will be open. There will be at least one individual (a gatekeeper) with the Association's computer system to determine if a voter is eligible to vote and if so whether a half or whole vote will be provided to the unit owner(s). At 7pm the tallying will commence with counsel overseeing the vote as in the past. One observer will be permitted in the front row and all other homeowners present must remain quiet to permit tallying.

Sprinkler system maintenance is the responsibility of individual homeowners. Sprinklers need to retract automatically and need to be installed below grade. Sprinkler damages to spray nozzles or heads hit because they are above grade and or not automatically retracting will not be repaired by the mowing contractor. Please, have irrigation system clocks set so all watering is completed by **8:30 AM daily**. If irrigation is running at time of cutting, that section of the lawn will be skipped until the next cutting cycle. If you have a issue with something that was **damaged** during the lawn cutting or some other issue, you must **call the office** and register a lawn complaint so the issue can be looked at and corrected.



Each Cycle is broken down into (8) day zones to complete the entire community. Zones below. It is an **estimated time frame**. If there are rainy days the time frame is extended.

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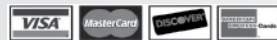

## HOLIDAY CITY SOUTH TRUSTEE ELECTION ABSENTEE BALLOT PROCEDURE

If you are unable to vote in person on Election Day - Tuesday, September 10, 2024, you can request an absentee ballot by following these procedures:

1. Call the clubhouse office at 732-341-8900 and request an absentee ballot. Once you are registered for an absentee ballot, you can either pick it up in person or request that it be mailed to you. If you pick the absentee ballot up at the office, you will be required to sign for it. If you request the ballot be sent in the mail, it will be mailed out beginning August 8th.
2. All completed ballots must be returned by mail directly to Legal Counsel at the address listed below.

Absentee ballots will be available on **August 8, 2024** at the clubhouse office, and need to be returned to by mail to **Karl T. Meth, Esq. at Becker 67 East Park Place Morristown, New Jersey 07960** and must be received by him by **September 5, 2024**. Homeowners must place their name on the outside of the envelope only. This will give the Legal Counsel the ability to ensure the voting homeowner is eligible to vote. Any absentee ballots that are returned without identification of the homeowner on the outside of the envelope will be discarded and not counted. If you choose to use an absentee ballot, make sure you follow the proper procedure and instructions to ensure your vote is counted.

# POOL NEWS

**I WOULD LIKE TO UPDATE YOU ON CHANGES AND IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE UPCOMING SEASON.**

First, we have a new sound system, long overdue, which will project the sound of music to both sides of the pool, rendering the use of other radios unnecessary and not recommended!

Second, during the Months of July, August, and September we will be showing large screen movies either on Friday or Saturday nights. When finalized we will publish the time schedule and movie to be shown in the Southwind and it will also be posted at the pool. *A great chance to watch a movie over pizza with friends!*

# POOL RULES

Rules & Regulations are posted inside & outside the pool area

- ❖ All badge holders must sign in with pool monitor for admittance and show ID badges which must be available for inspection at all times including guests.
- ❖ All persons are asked to shower before entering the water.
- ❖ Any persons showing evidence of (but not limited to) any communicable skin disease, sore, inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharge or if they are wearing bandages, will be denied admission to the pool area.
- ❖ Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any symptoms related to a gastrointestinal (stomach) disorder in the past seven (7) days.
- ❖ Children 4 to 18 years of age are permitted into the pool under supervision of an adult between the hours of 9:00 am and 1:00 pm daily. **No child or adult will be permitted in the pool with diapers of any kind.**
- ❖ Residents and Children are encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Accompanying adult should immediately report any accidents observed in the bathing waters to a pool monitor.
- ❖ No animals, with the exception of service/emotional support dogs with proper identification, will be permitted in the pool area.
- ❖ Long hair and beards need to be tied up while using the pool. Hair bands are available at the pool monitor station.
- ❖ **No alcohol** of any kind will be permitted in the pool enclosure. Glass containers are **prohibited** in or around the pool enclosure.
- ❖ Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be prohibited from entering the pool. Any person found to be drinking alcohol or under the influence of drugs while in the pool area will be escorted from the pool area and may be denied admittance for the remainder of the pool season.
- ❖ Food or snacks are permitted in and around the pool area. Pool area must remain clean at all times and cleaned before departing. All violations will be addressed.
- ❖ Conduct that endangers the safety and comfort of others is prohibited and could be cause for violators to be escorted from the pool area and may be denied admittance for the remainder of the pool season.
- ❖ Flotation devices, such as standard size noodles and children's water wings/swimmies are permitted in the pool. Any type of inflatable/blow-up tubes, rafts, flippers or swimming devices are not permitted in the pool.
- ❖ Only bathing suits are permitted in the pool. Cut-offs, street clothes or substitute swimwear are not allowed to be worn in the pool. This will be enforced by the pool monitor.
- ❖ For safety, and as a courtesy to others, please place footwear along the edge of the pool, but not near or around the handrails/steps used to entering or exiting the pool.  
For safety, and as a courtesy to others, please do not sit on the pool steps or near the step pool rails.
- ❖ No smoking or vaping will be allowed by the picnic tables or in the pool area. Designated smoking areas are posted.
- ❖ The pool will be closed, during inclement weather or emergencies.

August birthstones are the *Peridot* and the *Sardonyx*. *The Peridot* is a lime green color and said to host magical powers and healing properties to protect against nightmares and to bring the wearer power, influence, and a wonderful year. The second birthstone is the *Sardonyx*, a form of onyx and is recognized by its layers of reddish brown and white banding. It was popular with the ancient Greeks and Romans who carried into battle talismans of sardonyx engraved with images of heroes such as Mars or Hercules, believing that this would bring courage and victory.

## KIRMS PHOTOGRAPHY Sunrise And Sunset

Sunrise is getting later in the morning this time of year, so it's a great time to get our sunrise shots.

It is important to use the rule of thirds. Try not to put the sun in the middle of the frame. Place it toward the side. Having something in the foreground will strengthen your image.

If you want a silky look to the water, use a tripod and a long exposure. Sunrise images are much better with some clouds to reflect the sun's colors.

Check the monitor on the back of your camera to make certain the exposure is good. Your foreground objects will generally be silhouetted but you want them not to be completely dark.

If you include people in the shot and you don't want them silhouetted use your flash to light them up.

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# Letter To The Editor

My fellow Residents, In light of our most recent HOA meeting on July 11th, I felt compelled to share a few important points and sincerely hope that the Board (in its entirety) makes the much-needed changes and corrections as quickly as possible.

First , On the day of the election, No member of the Board of Trustees or election candidates should be allowed on HCS property (except for the time needed to cast their vote) during the voting hours. Since several residents acknowledged some election interference by a particular Board member, this has to be enforced during the very next upcoming election because it isn't guaranteed that the interference will stop. The residents have the right to come and vote without being approached or discouraged from voting for whom they choose to vote for. Board members often feel that the outcome of an election could have a negative impact on the dynamics of the group. While it's understandable to have certain preferences in candidates, it's unacceptable to act upon it by interfering, especially with lies. This can't be allowed to continue!

If a candidate isn't allowed to campaign positively for him/herself anywhere on HCS property, then neither should ANY presently seated Board member be allowed either, especially in a negative manner stating untruths. More importantly, it is extremely unethical for any board member to spread lies and misinformation either on or off the Clubhouse property about candidates based on unsubstantiated rumors passed on from other people. At the very least, I am suggesting that a strong letter of reprimand be placed in the board members file demonstrating the severity of his actions.

Second, at our last HOA meeting, the board continued to say that a problem which exists with our election wasn't their fault. The attorney announced that the election committee did nothing wrong. The attorney himself did not take any responsibility. So, who is responsible? My opinion: The day-to-day

operations of our association are run and manage by our board of trustees. When something goes wrong, it's up to them to admit where they may have failed, find a solution, fix it, and do their best to assure the homeowners that they will do everything in their power to make sure it never happens again. That statement was never made. It's very sad. Many residents have lost confidence in our board, because although they believe this is not their fault, they could not and did not provide the residents at that meeting a reason why and how it did happen. If the people running our organization have no clue, then we all should be very concerned. I am one very disappointed resident. Sincerely, Debbie Fazio.

At no time(except in an emergency) should any sitting board member make a decision on his or her own and act upon it (especially one with significant importance) without notifying and receiving approval from the entire board. Even if that person is the president. It's up to the other board members to insist upon this, so that they are always included and have a say in all decisions.

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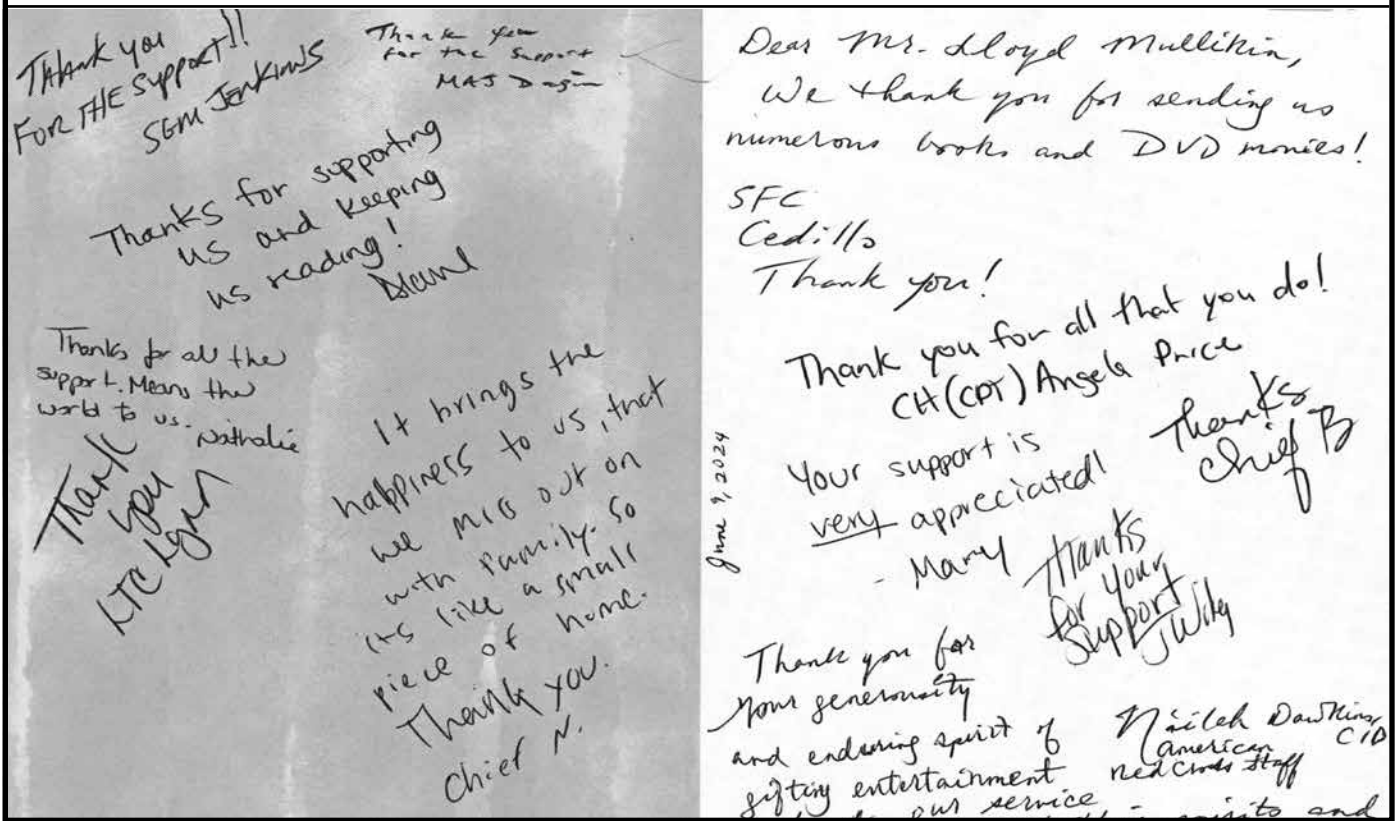

If plans are within the guidelines of our By-Laws, an approval letter will be prepared and given to the homeowner and submitted to the Zoning Board Officer of Berkeley Township to obtain a permit.

This pertains to any changes, additions, or alterations on the exterior of the home - roof, siding, paint, driveway, patio, sheds, etc.

Absolutely **NO WORK** can be started without permission from the Homeowners' Association or without a permit. **FINES WILL BE IMPOSED if this is not adhered to.**

### GARBAGE NOTICE

Garbage is **NOT** to be put out to the curb **before 4:00 PM on Mondays**. This is a Berkeley Township Ordinance and HCS residents must comply. Violators may be issued a fine for non-conformance by the Township and/or HCS. Trash receptacles must be kept in your garage, behind your home, or in an area out of view from the street. Receptacles must be covered and concealed. If you are away, consider having a friend or neighbor place your garbage cans at the curb and return them to their respective out-of-view locations after trash pickup.

With the outbreak of the **COVID-19 virus**, Berkeley Sanitation Department's rules for putting out trash is as follows: ***The Township has made key changes to trash pickup. All household trash must be bagged and placed in an outdoor trash receptacle. Sanitation employees will not pick up trash that is not bagged.***

## RECYCLING PICKUP

There have been many phone calls and emails regarding the pickup of recycling when the date for pickup falls on a holiday. The schedule that is provided by the Township states that recycling should be put out the Saturday before a Monday holiday. Discussion with the Township DPW supervisor provided us with information that should help with planning for the pickup of recycling when the schedule for pickup falls on a Monday holiday.

We were advised that when our recycling day is moved to another day due to a holiday, we are now on a pickup schedule with another section of the township which more than doubles the amount of recycling that will be picked up on that day.

With that thought in mind we need to understand the Township DPW will make every effort to pick up the recycling on the day denoted on the schedule. ***If they do not pick up your recycling by the end of the day on the scheduled day, please take your recycling in.*** This is an important step in the process. This will prevent recycling that is left out from getting blown around the neighborhood or ending up tangled in the swales and culverts on our common grounds. ***The DPW suggests that if your recycling does not get picked up on the scheduled day, we should put it out on the next regularly scheduled workday.*** In most cases that would be Tuesday, or Garbage pickup day. The DPW will continue to have recycling trucks making rounds until they are completely caught up and all the recycling is picked up.

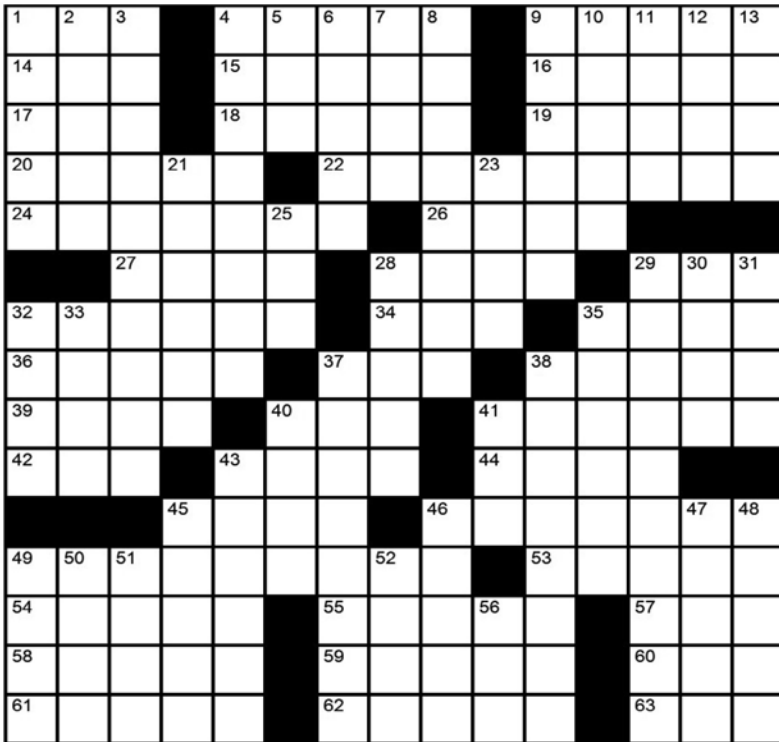

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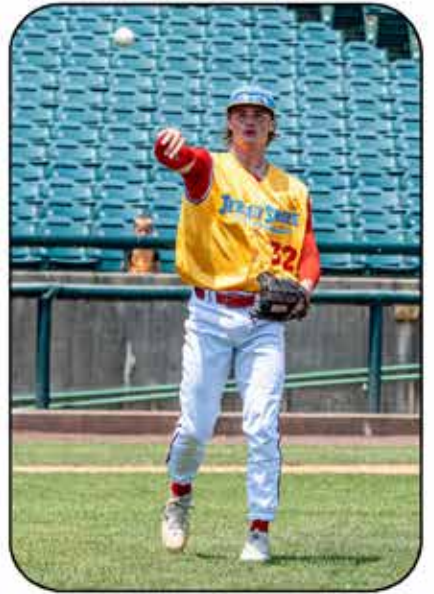
