### TREES IN THE COMMUNITY

Recently we have had several severe storms. Many of us have had tree limbs and or trees fall. The rule of thumb regarding these fallen trees and/or tree limbs is simple. If a tree or tree limb(s) that are in the common area fall in the common area, we leave the downed tree and/or tree limbs where they fall, unless they are creating a hazard. If a tree or tree limbs from the common area fall onto a member's property, the association will remove them. If a tree and /or tree limb do damage to a homeowner's home, they will have to file through their homeowner's insurance for damages, but the association will have the tree and/or tree limbs removed. Also, if the downed tree and/or tree limbs from a tree are from one that stood on the homeowner's property or the township right of way, the homeowner has responsibility for any damage they may cause. This should clarify the association policy for downed trees and/or tree limbs. If a homeowner has a tree on their property and would like to have it removed and are not sure if that tree is on their property for sure, please call the Code Committee and have them come check on it before removing anything. Berkeley Township requires that you have a permit to remove trees.

# Message from your President

September is here and the summer is behind us. We now begin our journey into the fall with cooler temperatures and the changing of the leaves.

The past few months have been difficult with certain members taking the opportunity to challenge the integrity of the Board once again. The level of frustration and distrust brought about threats of lawyers and lawsuits once again. What needs to be addressed is the integrity of the members of the Board with relation to past and recent allegations. Past accusations by individuals running for positions on the Board regarding misappropriation and/or theft of funds has been put to rest with a clean audit for 2023 and a forensic audit that provided solid proof that there was no misappropriation and/or theft of funds over the last 3 years. Regarding declarations by certain candidates that the Board has not been transparent with its financials. We will be publishing the financials for the first half of the year (showing balanced accounts) along with the findings from the 2023 audit and the forensic audit. The simple fact is the election was not run properly and although the Board cannot speak for past elections, our findings and corrections will ensure that the upcoming election and all future elections are implemented correctly and fairly.

Knowing that your Board of Trustees has and always will have the best interests of the members and the

association at heart is a fact. This cannot and will not be undone with false accusations to progress individual(s) self-serving interests. With all the attacks on the Board, the defaming remarks on social media as well as the continuous bantering with false information to the membership over the past few years have set the groundwork and a direction for failure. The continuous efforts to hinder the remediation of the Building C Auditorium is a perfect example of this.

This Board and/or any of its members should not put themselves in a position to support any one candidate, but we should all encourage everyone to get out and vote, based on facts. Voting will be in the Auditorium on September 10<sup>th</sup> from 11:00 am to 7:00 pm. The voting and the official count will be conducted by outside agencies that will ensure this election is handled properly and certify the results.

We look forward to seeing everyone at the September 12th Homeowners Meeting. I will end this month's message with the following quote: "Be kind to everyone on the way up; you'll meet the same people on the way down" - Wilson Mizner, Walter Winchell, and Jimmy Durante (all candidates for authorship).

# POOL RULES

# Rules & Regulations are posted inside & outside the pool area

- All badge holders must sign in with pool monitor for admittance and show ID badges which must be available for inspection at all times including guests.
- All persons are asked to shower before entering the water.
- Any persons showing evidence of (but not limited to) any communicable skin disease, sore, inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharge or if they are wearing bandages, will be denied admission to the pool area.
- Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any symptoms related to a gastrointestinal (stomach) disorder in the past seven (7) days.
- Children 4 to 18 years of age are permitted into the pool under supervision of an adult between the hours of 9:00 am and 1:00 pm daily. No child or adult will be permitted in the pool with diapers of any kind.
- Residents and Children are encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Accompanying adult should immediately report any accidents observed in the bathing waters to a pool monitor.
- No animals, with the exception of service/emotional support dogs with proper identification, will be permitted in the pool area.
- Long hair and beards need to be tied up while using the pool. Hair bands are available at the pool monitor station.
- No alcohol of any kind will be permitted in the pool enclosure. Glass containers are **prohibited** in or around the pool enclosure.
- Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be prohibited from entering the pool. Any person found to be drinking alcohol or under the influence of drugs while in the pool area will be escorted from the pool area and may be denied admittance for the remainder of the pool season.
- ❖ Food or snacks are permitted in and around the pool area. Pool area must remain clean at all times and cleaned before departing. All violations will be addressed.
- Conduct that endangers the safety and comfort of others is prohibited and could be cause for violators to be escorted from the pool area and may be denied admittance for the remainder of the pool season.
- Flotation devices, such as standard size noodles and children's water wings/swimmies are permitted in the pool. Any type of inflatable/blow-up tubes, rafts, flippers or swimming devices are not permitted in the pool.
- Only bathing suits are permitted in the pool. Cut-offs, street clothes or substitute swimwear are not allowed to be worn in the pool. This will be enforced by the pool monitor.
- For safety, and as a courtesy to others, please place footwear along the edge of the pool, but not near or around the handrails/steps used to entering or exiting the pool. For safety, and as a courtesy to others, please do not sit on the pool steps or near the step pool rails.
- No smoking or vaping will be allowed by the picnic tables or in the pool area. Designated smoking areas are posted.
- The pool will be closed, during inclement weather or emergencies.

His commitment to faith was evident through teaching CCD and serving as a **Eucharistic Minister at Ascension Church in New** Milford, NJ.

Richard's move to Toms River brought new avenues of community involvement, including overseeing the decorating committee, serving as President of the Social Club, and being elected as a member of the HCS Trustee committee.

If plans are within the guidelines of our By-Laws, an approval letter will be prepared and given to the homeowner and submitted to the Zoning Board Officer of Berkeley Township to obtain a permit.

This pertains to any changes, additions, or alterations on the exterior of the home - roof, siding, paint, driveway, patio, sheds, etc.

Absolutely **NO WORK** can be started without permission from the Homeowners' Association or without a permit. **FINES WILL BE IMPOSED if this is not adhered to.** 

#### **GARBAGE NOTICE**

Garbage is <u>NOT</u> to be put out to the curb <u>before 4:00 PM on Mondays</u>. This is a Berkeley Township Ordinance and HCS residents must comply. Violators may be issued a fine for non-conformance by the Township and/or HCS. Trash receptacles must be kept in your garage, behind your home, or in an area out of view from the street. Receptacles must be covered and concealed. If you are away, consider having a friend or neighbor place your garbage cans at the curb and return them to their respective out-of-view locations after trash pickup.

With the outbreak of the **COVID-19 virus**, Berkeley Sanitation Department's rules for putting out trash is as follows: *The Township has made key changes to trash pickup.* <u>All household trash must be bagged and placed in an outdoor trash receptacle.</u> Sanitation employees will not pick up trash that is not bagged.

#### RECYCLING PICKUP

There have been many phone calls and emails regarding the pickup of recycling when the date for pickup falls on a holiday. The schedule that is provided by the Township states that recycling should be put out the Saturday before a Monday holiday. Discussion with the Township DPW supervisor provided us with information that should help with planning for the pickup of recycling when the schedule for pickup falls on a Monday holiday.

We were advised that when our recycling day is moved to another day due to a holiday, we are now on a pickup schedule with another section of the township which more than doubles the amount of recycling that will be picked up on that day.

With that thought in mind we need to understand the Township DPW will make every effort to pick up the recycling on the day denoted on the schedule. If they do not pick up your recycling by the end of the day on the scheduled day, please take your recycling in. This is an important step in the process. This will prevent recycling that is left out from getting blown around the neighborhood or ending up tangled in the swales and culverts on our common grounds. The DPW suggests that if your recycling does not get picked up on the scheduled day, we should put it out on the next regularly scheduled workday. In most cases that would be Tuesday, or Garbage pickup day. The DPW will continue to have recycling trucks making rounds until they are completely caught up and all the recycling is picked up.

Everyone's patience and cooperation are greatly appreciated.
