TREES IN THE COMMUNITY

Recently we have had several severe storms. Many of us have had tree limbs and or trees fall. The rule of thumb regarding these fallen trees and/or tree limbs is simple. If a tree or tree limb(s) that are in the common area fall in the common area, we leave the downed tree and/or tree limbs where they fall, unless they are creating a hazard. If a tree or tree limbs from the common area fall onto a member's property, the association will remove them. If a tree and /or tree limb do damage to a homeowner's home, they will have to file through their homeowner's insurance for damages, but the association will have the tree and/or tree limbs removed. Also, if the downed tree and/or tree limbs from a tree are from one that stood on the homeowner's property or the township right of way, the homeowner has responsibility for any damage they may cause. This should clarify the association policy for downed trees and/or tree limbs. If a homeowner has a tree on their property and would like to have it removed and are not sure if that tree is on their property for sure, please call the Code Committee and have them come check on it before removing anything. Berkeley Township requires that you have a permit to remove trees.

I have a few announcements to make,

1. Starting with the Trustee meeting on Thursday October 10th. The Trustee workshop portion of that meeting will be open to the public. Meeting will start at 10am in Building A room #1. At the conclusion of that meeting the board will retire for the Executive session which will not be open to the public. The Board will always meet on the second and fourth Thursday of the month and the residents are invited to attend the workshop portions of those meetings
2. We are beginning to start reconstruction of the Shuffleboard courts and replacement of sections of concrete along the side of Building B. Costs associated with these projects are to be charged to our Reserve account and the funds have been previously set aside for this purpose.
3. Minutes from the September Homeowner meeting are not in this issue of the Southwind as we had difficulty with the transcription service. Your November Southwind will include both the September and October Homeowner minutes. We will also post the September minutes to our website (hcsnj.org) as soon as possible. My closing advice is "believe what you see, not what you hear."

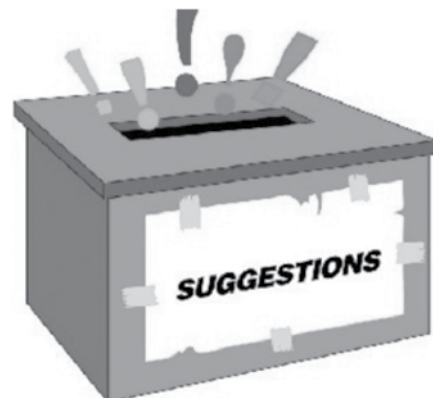

Absolutely **NO** exterior additions, changes, or alterations of any kind can be made until the plans and specifications showing all details are submitted to the Code Committee and approved by the Board.

If plans are within the guidelines of our By-Laws, an approval letter will be prepared and given to the homeowner and submitted to the Zoning Board Officer of Berkeley Township to obtain a permit.

This pertains to any changes, additions, or alterations on the exterior of the home - roof, siding, paint, driveway, patio, sheds, etc.

Absolutely **NO WORK** can be started without permission from the Homeowners' Association or without a permit. **FINES WILL BE IMPOSED if this is not adhered to.**

GARBAGE NOTICE

Garbage is **NOT** to be put out to the curb **before 4:00 PM on Mondays**. This is a Berkeley Township Ordinance and HCS residents must comply. Violators may be issued a fine for non-conformance by the Township and/or HCS. Trash receptacles must be kept in your garage, behind your home, or in an area out of view from the street. Receptacles must be covered and concealed. If you are away, consider having a friend or neighbor place your garbage cans at the curb and return them to their respective out-of-view locations after trash pickup.

With the outbreak of the **COVID-19 virus**, Berkeley Sanitation Department's rules for putting out trash is as follows: ***The Township has made key changes to trash pickup. All household trash must be bagged and placed in an outdoor trash receptacle. Sanitation employees will not pick up trash that is not bagged.***

RECYCLING PICKUP

There have been many phone calls and emails regarding the pickup of recycling when the date for pickup falls on a holiday. The schedule that is provided by the Township states that recycling should be put out the Saturday before a Monday holiday. Discussion with the Township DPW supervisor provided us with information that should help with planning for the pickup of recycling when the schedule for pickup falls on a Monday holiday.

We were advised that when our recycling day is moved to another day due to a holiday, we are now on a pickup schedule with another section of the township which more than doubles the amount of recycling that will be picked up on that day.

With that thought in mind we need to understand the Township DPW will make every effort to pick up the recycling on the day denoted on the schedule. ***If they do not pick up your recycling by the end of the day on the scheduled day, please take your recycling in.*** This is an important step in the process. This will prevent recycling that is left out from getting blown around the neighborhood or ending up tangled in the swales and culverts on our common grounds. ***The DPW suggests that if your recycling does not get picked up on the scheduled day, we should put it out on the next regularly scheduled workday.*** In most cases that would be Tuesday, or Garbage pickup day. The DPW will continue to have recycling trucks making rounds until they are completely caught up and all the recycling is picked up.

Everyone's patience and cooperation are greatly appreciated.

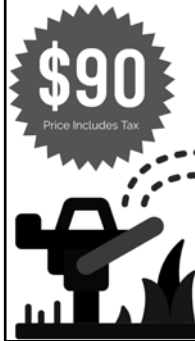

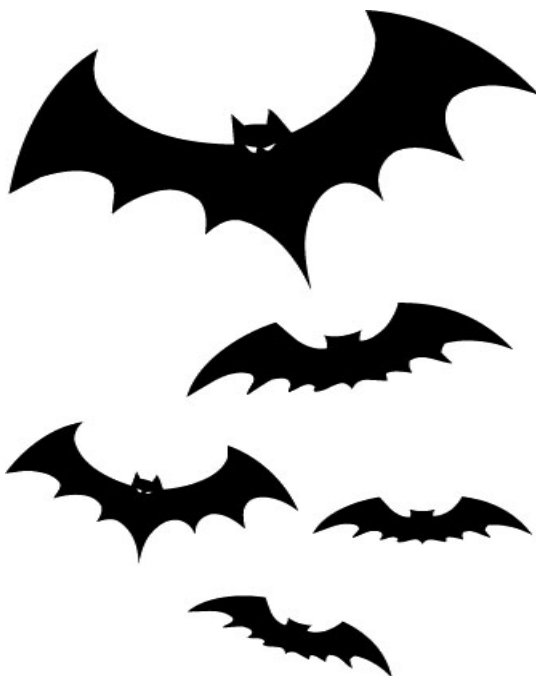
