Legislation: S4104: Recently S4104 introduced by Senator Michael Testa, which would establish "a procedure permitting constituent homeowners to dissolve their common interest community through a two-thirds majority vote affirming a compliant plan for dissolution, as submitted to the executive board of the association following a petition signed by at least 25 percent of the association members." Our 9th Legislative District is aware of this legislation and is keeping a watchful eye on it. We will keep you updated if this bill moves forward.

New Scam Alerts: 1) Recently scammers have contacted seniors advising them they owe money to the **IRS** and to avoid additional fines they should submit payment through the link provided. The IRS will always contact you by letter, never contact through email or telephone. 2) **Census scam:** people representing the US Census employees are asking for your Social Security number, birthdate and other personal information. The **Census Bureau** does not do that. A census is run every 10 years. We are not due until 2030. Never click on a link you are not familiar with or give out any personal information through an email or text message.

Recycle Coach: Receive weekly reminders of your scheduled garbage and recycle pick ups. Recycle Coach also provides helpful suggestions on various topics. You can obtain the app through your mobile app store. It is beneficial and free.

Wood Fire Pit Requirements - As open burn of any kind without a permit is prohibited, commercially purchased fire pits for residential usage only, are permitted if the following requirements are satisfied. Total fuel area must be less than 36 inches in width, length or diameter and not more than 24 inches in height, the fire pit must have legs and is off the ground and the fire pit is covered with a mandatory ember/spark screen. The ember/spark screen is required to be in place at all times during the usage of the fire pit. The location of the fire pit shall be away from all combustible materials. Fire pit usage is prohibited when the NJFFS has issued a "Red Flag Warning". The burning of paper, leaves or other waste vegetation is also prohibited. Any type of fire pit, commercial or homemade, not meeting the stated requirements is considered "Open Burning" and thereby prohibited from usage, unless a permit is applied for and issued. Further information can be found on the State of NJ website or questions can be directed to the NJFFS 973-962-0217.

Fulfill News: Guest Speaker: Heather deJong, Deputy Executive Director of OC Meals on Wheels:

- Meals on Wheels offers more than meals to older adults age 60+ who can no longer prepare meals for themselves.
- Fulfill is completely funded by the Older American's Act, OC Commissioners, USDA, donations and a voluntary \$3 daily donation to the participants.
- Speakers are available to discuss emergency and safety awareness.
- St. Francis Social Services located in BT Municipal building is a one-stop service center. They process intake for Meals on Wheels, Medicare, PAAD, and other benefits our seniors may qualify for.
- Fulfill is partnered with 2 churches that delivers emergency food boxes to those in need.
- When we arrive at your home, we knock, wait for someone to answer and hand them the meal. We will not leave a meal unless we see the participant, insuring they are okay. Participants have peace of mind knowing someone will be there around the same time every day.
- Meals provided are 1/3 of required dietary nutrition (protein, starch, vegetable). Every Monday we distribute a cold bag including granola, banana, bread and butter Everyone gets the same daily meals.
- If something looks off to the driver, the emergency contact is contacted to check on their loved ones.
- Meals on Wheels operates community cafés throughout OC, including Manahawkin. In addition to the meal, Zumba, and other physical activities such as chair volleyball or chair aerobics are offered.

Questions about Social Media and the Truth - Part III

This is the “third” message from the Board related to information posted on social media. The following will provide the general membership with information verified to be correct and truthful, in an effort to maintain complete “transparency”.

It appears that the truth is an anomaly when posting on social media. The recent posts are as far from the truth as you can imagine. The individuals who post information for their “*chosen*” followers should confirm the facts prior to posting. By posting their personal opinions and not the facts, they are performing an injustice not only to the community, but especially their “*chosen*” followers.

Let’s begin with a post entitled “Thoughts about the June Newsletter”. The graphics were very good and with that in mind if the individual who created the banner put their talent to better use – imagine the benefit the community could reap.

Now let’s move onto a few recent posts that provided information that was not factual.

The complaint about the sample ballot in the Southwind having the word “Sample” across the candidate’s names. That is the norm when dealing with sample ballots. It is done to prevent voter fraud. This is nothing new. It should also be noted that the individual whose name was covered did not complain when advised that her name was covered, she understood.

It was also stated in posts that the Board, while acting in full transparency, is providing information that is fabricated in the name of “transparency”. Using the words stated in recent posts “***BS’ contrived to unjustly influence voters***”. They also declared that “***OUR own newsletter ‘We’ fund is being used to spread the ‘BS’ right before the election***”. The fact is the newsletter (Southwind) is not funded by the membership. In fact, it is a revenue stream for the association. If the person posting the misinformation had done their research, they would have checked the posted budget for 2026 on our official web site for all the members to view or maybe even come into the office to review it. What would have been revealed is line item 40501 under income that provides the association with \$19,250.00 per year or a little over \$1,600 a month in positive cash flow. So, using the Southwind to provide truthful information to the membership costs the membership nothing.

There was a post regarding a pool umbrella blowing away and landing on the shuffleboard court. This is not the first time that this has happened and having one “*particular individual*” on site would not have prevented it or changed the outcome. The truth is every effort is always made to ensure the safety of our members.

There was a post on social media regarding the Homeowners Meetings, stating they are nothing more than lectures. The fact is the meetings are supposed to be informational, providing the membership with updates and open dialog pertaining to association matters. They are not meant to turn the meetings into a personal complaint platform. The constant negative posting directed at the current Board has no positive effect on the community and it appears that members are starting to realize the same.

A quote from one of the followers “***I think I have to stop reading it; it’s just too disturbing and upsetting. It’s interfering with my peace of mind***” That quote alone says it all. The only interest the administrators of the social media site have is to create chaos and undermine a system that has worked effectively for many decades providing a peaceful retirement community with a lifestyle the majority of people enjoy.

The rebuttals being printed in the Southwind over the past few months have been prompted by members who write to the Board. They wonder why we don’t respond to individuals who have no motive other than to disrupt our quiet, friendly neighborhood. The fact is the more these untruths are posted the more we receive communications from members of the community wanting to know why we don’t respond. It has become more evident that members are also starting to realize the untruths contained within those posts are hurting the community. Everything written or provided in the statements provided in the Southwind are factual and backed up by documentation. The statements are not propaganda, contrived or unjust. They are simply answers to the untruths that have been posted on social media.

Until the social media propaganda ends, we will continue to provide factual information for all the membership. Remember, when reading social media posts, always get the facts before believing what is posted. Your Trustees are always available to provide correct, factual information.

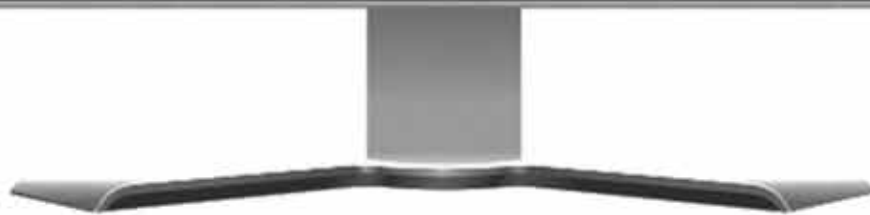

Nextrex has changed their reward program. They no longer will award a park bench after collecting 1,000lbs in a 12 month period. Starting in 2026 for each 250lbs collected, in a quarter, we earn one chance in a drawing for a \$500 credit. In the second quarter we are close to entering two chances. At the end of each quarter, twenty-five lucky organizations are selected. Organizations are selected in a random drawing and may use the credit to acquire a variety of prizes. These changes mean we may or may not receive any physical reward for our efforts.

If you would like to pay your maintenance dues by credit card, at the bottom of the coupon there is space for the information required. You can also call or stop by the clubhouse office with your information.

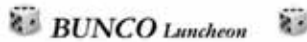

Absolutely **NO** exterior additions, changes, or alterations of any kind can be made until the plans and specifications showing all details are submitted to the Code Committee and approved by the board.

If plans are within the guidelines of our By-Laws, a form will be filled out by the homeowner so they can submit it to the Zoning Board Officer of Berkeley Township, to obtain a permit if needed.

This pertains to any changes, additions, or alterations on the exterior of the home - roof, siding, paint, driveway, patio, sheds, etc.

Absolutely **NO WORK** can be started without permission from the Homeowner's Association or without a permit. ***FINES WILL BE IMPOSED if this is not adhered to.***

GARBAGE NOTICE

Garbage is **NOT** to be put out to the curb **before 4:00 PM on Mondays**. This is a Berkeley Township Ordinance and HCS residents must comply. Violators may be issued a fine for non-conformance by the Township and/or HCS. Trash receptacles must be kept in your garage, behind your home, or in an area out of view from the street. Receptacles must be covered and concealed. If you are away, consider having a friend or neighbor place your garbage cans at the curb and return them to their respective out-of-view locations after trash pickup.

With the outbreak of the **COVID-19 virus**, Berkeley Sanitation Department's rules for putting out trash is as follows: **The Township has made key changes to trash pickup. All household trash must be bagged and placed in an outdoor trash receptacle.** Sanitation employees will not pick up trash that is not bagged.

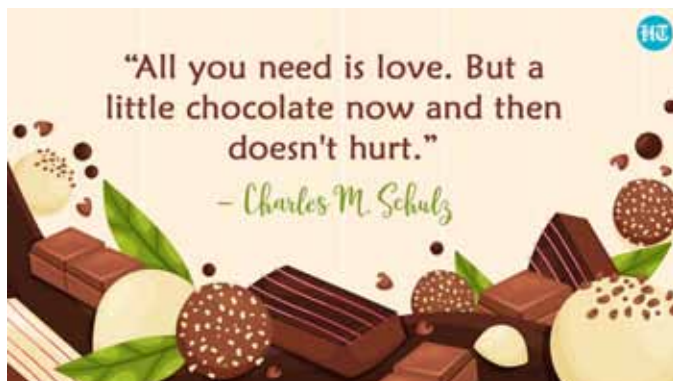

- ❖ All persons must shower before entering the water.
- ❖ Any persons showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, sore, inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharge or if they are wearing bandages will be denied admission to the pool area.
- ❖ Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any symptoms related to a gastrointestinal (stomach) disorder in the past seven (7) days.
- ❖ Children 4 to 18 years of age are permitted into the pool under supervision of an adult between the hours of 9:00 am and 1:00 pm daily. **No child will be permitted in the pool with diapers of any kind.**
- ❖ Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Accompanying adult should immediately report any accidents observed in the bathing waters to a pool monitor.
- ❖ No animals, with the exception of service dogs, will be permitted in the pool area.
- ❖ Long hair and bearded need to be tied up while using the pool. Hair bands are available at the pool monitor station.
- ❖ **No alcohol** of any kind will be permitted in or around the pool area. Drinks must be in a clear plastic container or an approved insulated/thermos container. Glass containers are **prohibited** in or around the pool area.
- ❖ Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be prohibited from entering the pool. Any person found to be drinking alcohol or under the influence of drugs while in the pool area will be escorted from the pool area and denied admittance for the remainder of the pool season.
- ❖ Food or snacks are permitted in the pool area. Coolers no larger than 16" by 16" (with wheels) are permitted.
- ❖ Conduct that endangers the safety and comfort of others is prohibited and could be cause for violators to be escorted from the pool area and denied admittance for the remainder of the pool season.
- ❖ Flotation devices, such as noodles (no longer than the size of the pool monitor's table) and children's water wings/swimmies are permitted in the pool. Any type of inflatable/blow-up tubes, rafts, flippers or swimming devices are not permitted in the pool.
- ❖ Only bathing suits are permitted in the pool. Cut-offs, street clothes or substitute swimwear are not allowed to be worn in the pool.
- ❖ For safety, and as a courtesy to others, please place footwear along the edge of the pool, but not near or around the handrails used to entering or exiting the pool. No jumping in the pool, including from steps or stairs.
- ❖ No smoking or vaping will be allowed by the picnic tables or in the pool area.
- ❖ The pool will be closed, at the discretion of the pool staff or the Trustees, during inclement weather or emergencies.
- ❖ Only music provided by monitor is permitted. No outside music is allowed.

THE POOL RULES WILL BE ENFORCED FOR A PLEASURABLE POOL EXPERIENCE AND SAFETY FOR ALL MEMBERS AND THEIR GUESTS.

Residents must bring their guest badges and the guests **MUST WEAR THEM AT ALL TIMES.** Residents must obtain these guest badges back before their guests leave the facility.
